Ms. LENDON GRAY, NY - DRESSAGE



Ms. Gray has been riding horses for almost 50 years, participating in World Championships and the Olympics, and owning and operating a successful stable. Although she rode Warmbloods in her 2 Olympics, the World Championships, and the World Cup, her ponies held a special place in her heart. She is extremely active with the USET, AHSA, USDF. Her greatest energies go to trying to develop all riders, juniors especially, to learn correct basics and become all-round horsemen. MRS. MUFFY SEATON, SC - DRIVING



Mrs. Seaton, from Williston, SC, is a well-known driver, trainer, and breeder of driving ponies. She has been an active CDE and Pleasure Driving competitor, judge, and clinician for the past 28 years. In addition, Mrs. Seaton has served on ADS and USEF driving committees and has been the Mid-Atlantic Regional ADS Representative for 3 years. She is a registered USEF and ADS judge in Pleasure, Combined Driving, and Driving Dressage. MRS. CHRISTINE ROBINSON, UK - PONY • CASPIAN HORSE





Mrs. Robinson is well-qualified to judge our first SANA competition for the pony breeds. She is a well-rounded M&M (Mixed Mountain & Moorland Native Ponies) judge - in-hand, driven, ridden, and WHP classes - for nearly 15 years, a pony competitor herself in many disciplines, and breeder of traditional Fell ponies under the Kerbec prefix. She has judged coloured ponies, hunters, and riding ponies classes and shows. Mrs. Robinson is currently VP of the Fell Pony Society [UK] and serves on four committees.

MRS. HEATHER CHAPLIN, UK - OVER FENCE • IRISH DRAUGHT



Mrs. Chaplin is a breeder of traditional Irish Draughts and is on the panel of judges and inspectors for the Irish Draught Society of Great Britain (www.idhsgb.com), a daughter society of the IDS [Ireland]. She is qualified to judge in-hand classes, hunter, and ridden classes alongside ride-only judges.

MRS. WENDY FORBES, USA - CLEVELAND BAY



Mrs. Forbes is a long-time steward and breeder of quality Cleveland Bays. She is the only American on the panel of judges for the Cleveland Bay Society [UK] (www.clevelandbay.com) and the only American to have judged the *King George V Cup* - the prestigious UK breed show - to select the Champion Premium Cleveland Bay stallion which also includes classes for 1, 2 & 3 year old pure colts together with a Pure and Part-Bred Ridden class.

MRS. SABINE TOEPFER-GEBERT, GER - AKHAL-TEKE



Mrs. Toepfer-Gebert, past president of the German Akhal-Teke Association, is a veterinary surgeon in Germany with her own practice and is a certified Level B riding instructor. Best known as one of Europe's most prominent Akhal-Teke breeders, the list of Tekes she has owned or bred reads like a Who's Who among Teke enthusiasts. To benefit conservation of the breed, she commissioned translations of several Russian breed manuscripts. She is respected globally by the Teke community for her integrity, modesty, and extensive knowledge and deep understanding of the Akhal-Teke horse.

Speakers

DR. GUS COTHRAN, Ph.D., TEXAS A&M - "Breeding Strategies for a Small Gene Pool"

KEYNOTE SPEAKER

Born and reared in Texas, Dr. Cothran graduated from El Paso-Burgess High School. From there, he attended North Texas State University in Denton, obtaining his BS and MS degrees in Biology. He received his PhD in genetics from the University of Oklahoma in 1982. His PhD research was on the genetics of speciation in ground dwelling squirrels. From OU, he went to the University of Georgia's Savannah River Ecology Laboratory near Aiken, South Carolina. There his work was primarily involved in population genetic studies of white-tailed deer. His next stop was the Southwest Foundation for Biomedical Research in San Antonio, Texas where he worked on genetics of horses and a species of South American opossum. From there, he moved to the University of Kentucky in 1986. At UK, he was the Director of the Equine Parentage Testing and Research Laboratory and Research Professor in the Department of Veterinary Science.

In 2006, he moved to Texas A&M University where he is Clinical Professor in the Dept of Veterinary Integrative Biosciences, which is in the College of Veterinary Medicine and Biomedical Science. He has a genotyping laboratory that does typing on horses, cattle, dogs and cats. He is involved in research in genetic mapping, genetics of specific characteristics (such as coat color and hereditary disease), population genetics and conservation genetics of rare breeds. He is married and has a daughter and son.

DR. ANNE BLAKELY, Ph.D., BALL ST UNIV - "Equine Master Data Base"

Born in Athens, GA, Ann was raised primarily in Texas interrupted by a two-year stay in Tehran, Iran where she had the opportunity to ride Turkomen Horses at the Caspian Horse Farm at Nozoroubad and the (former) Shah's Imperial Riding Academy. Graduating from New Braunfels High School, TX, she attended Texas A&M, obtained a BS in Biochemistry and MS in the Genetics Area Program. She received a PhD in Genetics from the Univ of MO -Columbia in 1993, her PhD research focused on the genetics of Eastern gamagrass, and comparative genetic mapping within related species. Working for the USDA-ARS Southern Plains Range Research Station (Woodward, OK) & the Plant Genetics Research Unit (Columbia, MO), her work involved the study of the control of reproduction (particularly sexual reproduction, or meiosis) in the cereal grasses and higher organisms. In 1995, she moved to Ball State Univ, Muncie, IN where she is now an Assoc. Professor of Genetics in the Dept of Biology, College of Sciences & Humanities. Her lab uses comparative data analysis to isolate and clone genes of interest associated with sexual reproduction, structural variations, disease, and population and evolution studies in the cereal grasses. She is involved in research in biocomputational and bioinformatics methods of genome analyses and modeling in higher (non-bacterial) organisms.

Serving as the advisor to the BSU Genetics Club and the BSU SPUR student volunteer organization, an equine-assisted therapy riding programs in East Central IN. She is married, with 5 cats, and a Belgian Terveuren; and is forever working on becoming a better dressage rider (*Perfection is a state of becoming, not a state of being*).

Ms. KARIN BERGENER, P.A. - NAIS - Changing Horse Ownership As We Know It?

Karin Bergener, a fellow horse owner, is an Ohio attorney with a small farm, where she raises goats, sheep, and chickens. She has been working against and writing about the National Animal Identification System (NAIS) for over two years. She is one of the founding members of the Liberty Ark Coalition www.LibertyArk.com, formed to bring together people from all parts of the political spectrum, to focus on one issue - fighting NAIS. 

DALES PONY - NORTHERN ENGLAND

Closely related to the Fell, the larger Dales has been used as a pack pony, on the farm for shepherding and hunting, and as light draft in WWI & II. Possessing outstanding stamina at the trot, and their extreme strength and agility make Dales masters of versatility, earning them the title "Great All 'Rounder".



DARTMOOR PONY - DARTMOOR, ENGLAND

A quality Dartmoor should give one the impression of elegance and strength, with a pretty pony head and a flowing mane and tail. Movement should never be excessive, but rather free flowing, low and honest, and always sure-of-foot. Small in stature and long known as an outstanding child's pony.

Dartmoors are fun in harness for adults too.

EST status: "Vulnerable"



EXMOOR PONY - EXMOOR, ENGLAND

Small, hardy ponies designed by Mother Nature for survival, but well suited for riding or driving. Their uniformity of color and type attests to their ancient, pure ancestry. Exmoors are clever and sensible, giving trust and obedience when shown leadership and respect. Considered the oldest and purest of the Native Pony breeds, they are also one of the most endangered. EST status: "CRITICAL"



FELL PONY - NORTHERN ENGLAND

The Fell Pony is a large Native Pony from the hills of Cumbria in northern England. Known for its hardiness, surefootedness and strong constitution, Fells are the closest relative of the extinct Scottish Galloway. Kind enough for experienced youth, strong enough to carry a man, excellent driving pony, it is said, "You cannot put a Fell to the wrong job!"

GOTLAND - RUSS PONY - GOTLAND, SWEDEN

Primitive looking and pony sized, Gotlands come from the Swedish Baltic Isles, possibly descended from the Tarpan. Once popular for work in coal mines, they are versatile, hardy, long-lived. NEWFOUNDLAND PONY - CANADIAN EAT COAT

Hailing from the founding of the Canadian coast, the Newfoundland is a medium to large pony with a genetic package of 19th Century Mountain & Moorland ponies and extinct Scottish Galloway without the 19th & 20th Centuries 'improvements'. Fast learners with an intense desire to please, they excel in any discipline, and are one on the few pony breeds developed in N.A.

AKHAL-TEKE - TURKMENIJTAN

Research suggesting they predate the Arabian and influenced the Thoroughbred, the Teke reigned as a war horse supreme in ancient times. Naturally gaited - known as the Cadillac of Rides & Family horse - calm, willing, surefooted, outstanding pleasure/trail mount. EST status: "CRITICAL"


SANA classes should be viewed as an educational tool to aid in the conservation. Prizes are simply icing on the cake.
