

Equus Survival Trust Endangered Breed Pavilion

PURPOSE of Breed Pavilion

The Breed Pavilion is a generic area to promote your breed and your associations. It is not for farm or breeder material or any commercial ventures. Those items may be displayed in booths in the Indoor tradeshow area. We encourage you to have generic breed and association hand-outs, small signage and display items for your breed association on your table.

If you have a small pony breed, your participants may wish to consider bringing or buying a bale of straw or hay for children to stand on just outside your stall to be able to better view the ponies. You are welcome to bring stall guards to enable you to keep your stall door open *if you are in constant attendance*. Stall guard installation must not violate any KHP regulations.

PARTICIPATION COSTS

Display fee – NONE As a SANA breed (a breed having Breed classes in the SANA competition), the fee for participation is being underwritten by the Equus Survival Trust.

Shavings - Bedding is to be cost shared by your participants in any manner the Team Captain arranges. Shavings can be brought in or purchased on site at Devers (859) 233-9702. **It is the Team Captain's responsibility to have the stall bedded in time for Friday opening.**

LAYOUT, DECOR & DISPLAY

Over a dozen breed stalls will be included in the Breed Pavilion in the portion that faces the Outdoor Ring, Stalls are 10x10, full wooden walls on the sides and back, with a half wall on front topped by bars. The door slides.

The Trust will provide breed signage and a tablecloth for a square card-size table to put next to the stall under the overhang. **Each breed is responsible for bringing a square card-size table & chairs to share. (1-2 chairs should be sufficient)**

The grassy area directly in front of the Breed Pavilion can be used to bring a display horse out of its stall for better viewing.

KHP REGULATIONS

Please have all participants familiar with KHP Regulations. They are posted on the EST website and will be provided in hard copy to Team Captains in their check-in packets.

FPA Release Form

All persons working in the Breed Pavilion area must have a signed Festivale Participation Agreement on file with the Festivale management. These can be given to the Barn Manager Crista Baker at Check-In or forwarded via mail or attachments prior to the Festivale to Victoria Tollman.

ROTATIONS & DISPLAY HORSES

Each breed community is responsible for determining which and how many horses/ponies to rotate through their display stall. This includes representation from all breed associations and any individual members outside these organizations that are EST members. The Team

Captains will be instrumental in helping determine the horses involved in the rotations and will provide a list of the horses and owner contacts to the Breed Pavilion Manager Crista Baker prior to the opening of the Breed Pavilion.

All display participants must meet the following requirements:

- (1) Horses must be purebreds & meet the general breed standard criteria.
- (2) Horses must be of good temperament considered safe for public display. Friendly, people-oriented horses are best. Stallions are permitted as long as they remained tractable.
- (3) Horses must be owned by members of either an EST affiliate breed organization or by an individual member of the Equus Survival Trust.
- (4) Safety and the well-being of the horses and the public are our top priority. Owners, Team Captains & the Festivale Breed Pavilion/Barn Manager have the right to pull any horse deemed unhappy or unsafe.
- (5) Owners/attendants must bring their own water bucket and hay. Each must clean the stall immediately after their rotation is over and BEFORE the next horse arrives. A muck bucket and rake will be provided. All manure must be placed in KHP designated areas.
- (6) The Breed Pavilion management is broken down by breed starting with its designated display stall under the management each Team Captain. Team Captains report directly to the Breed Pavilion Manager, Crista Baker who reports to the SANA & Grounds Manager, Billy Cave who reports to Event Manager Victoria Tollman. Please follow the chain of command so we can keep things running smoothly.

PAVILION HOURS & ROTATION TIMES

The Breed Pavilion is open Friday, Saturday and part of Sunday. Display Hours are Fri/Sat 9AM to 6PM and Sun 9AM to 2PM. Team Captains are responsible for the rotation times which will vary between breeds as some will have more representatives than others.

The object is to keep a horse on display at all times. (We realize this will not always be possible with the breeds who have few representatives who may be in demos or competing.) Typically, rotations are for 2-3 hours. Most horses are ready to be relieved after 3-4 hrs on display.

VACATING PREMISE

Upon the closing of the Pavilion on Sunday, each Team Captain is responsible for seeing that their display stall is stripped and the bedding is removed to KHP designated areas.
