Horses and Ponies physically compete in the same classes but are judged & pinned separately in their respective Divisions (1,2,3, etc.) & Rounds (a, b, c).

The same rider/horse combination can only enter 3 Height Divisions AND those must be consecutive even if they don't enter all the rounds in those Divisions. [Same horse with a different rider (or same rider with a different horse) can enter same or different divisions]

Each HEIGHT DIVISION (Pony /Horse) has 3 rounds per height a, b, c:

a = Optimum Time: Rider with fewest penalties and closest to optimum time wins
(Optimum Time is pre-determined by 3-day eventing guidelines)

b = Jump-Off: Rider with no penalties over jumps 1 - 10 can stay in ring for Jump Off Round.
Jump off consists of 5 jumps (for example: 2, 8, 5, 6, 7). Least penalties and fastest time wins.

c = Classic/Speed: Fewest penalties & fastest time wins.

-Time starts over the first jump and ends over last jump.

-Riders do not have to enter all 3 classes of one division but can enter individual rounds.

-Each individual round will have placings (ribbons 1st -6th)

-Each any Division with at least two rider/horse combos completing a, b, & c will have a Champion & Reserve
