On November 9-12, 2006, The Equus Survival Trust will be presenting three endangered breeds, the Caspian horse, the Fell pony, and the Dales pony in Springfield, Massachusetts at the nation's largest trade show, Equine Affaire.

The Equus Survival Trust is a nonprofit organization that helps save endangered horse breeds. The display will have an emphasis on education and will include an educational booth for these breeds, breed demonstrations, and display stalls open to the public.
